Out of the Past

Bay Fabbri, 1022 Harrison Avenue, well-known resident of Crystal Falls was appointed to membership on the Crystal Falls' City fire and police departments when the City Commission met Tuesday evening. Fabbri, born in Chicago in 1916 has spent the majority of his life in this City, succeeds Natale Tirapelli who resigned his patrolman position-fireman position last month to accept mine employment. Olinto Bay Fabbri came to Crystal Falls as a youth and is a 1936 graduate of Crystal Falls High School and has lived here continuously with an exception of a five-year period, 1937-1945 when he made his home in Ishpeming. He operated Bay's Coffee Shop (220 Superior) from 1946-48 and is currently employed as a bartender at the Crystal Inn (400 Superior). Fabbri is married to the former Rose Dallago and they have two children, Patricia (5) and Dennis (7 months). As an employee of the City, he will divide his time equally between the fire department and police force. His monthly salary will be \$193, the same as his predecessor.
