The soldiers who were buried on foreign soil will be coming home to loved ones and their final resting place. The list includes: Pfc Milton Farley, son of Mrs. Nellie Farley was killed in Luxembourg (12/26/1944); Pfc John Macurak, son of Mrs. Helen Macurak was killed in Germany (1/6/1945); Pfc William Magray son of Mr. and Mrs. William Magray was killed in Luxembourg (12/18/1945); S/Sgt Taumo Rambacka, son of Mrs. Toini Rambacka was killed in Luxembourg (12/18/1944); Pvt Harry Sherman, son Mr. and Mrs. Walter Sherman was killed in Leyte (11/11/1944); Sgt Roger Stoor, son of Mrs. Frank Carlson was killed in New Guinea (6/12/1944); Pvt John Valine, son of Mr. and Mrs. Oscar Valine was killed in Italy (1/22/1944) and Pvt Reino Wierikko, son of Mr. John Wierikko was killed in France (8/7/1944).
