March 28, 1896

W.H. Stephenson, foreman for the Menominee River Boom Company, has made his report of the logs banked on the various tributary streams of the Menominee River. Paint River – North Branch (31 million board feet); Paint River - South Branch (6.5 million); Paint River (4.5 million); Deer River (3.2 million); Fence River (11 million); Fence - North Branch (16 million); Fence – East Branch (8 million); Iron River (.3 million); Brule River (9 million); Pine River (31 million); Pine River – South Branch (9 million); Pine River – North Branch (3.2 million) and Pine Creek (10 million).

A staunch staircase has been constructed between the Park Store (309 Superior) and the Moriarty Building (317 Superior) this week and will be used by the tenants of the upper floors of both. Mr. Moriarty contemplates removing his law office thither in the near future.
